E-Waste and appliances accepted :	
-	TV's (Fee applies see website for current pricing)
-	Any device that plugs into a TV (dvd, vcr, gaming consoles, cable TV receiver, etc.)
-	Desktop computers, laptops, tablets
-	Accessories that plug into a computer (keyboards, mice, scanners, printers external hard drive, circuit board etc)
-	Computer monitors
-	Fax machines, telephones, copiers, CB and ham radios
-	Stereo receivers, radios, boomboxes
-	iPods, cell phones and digital cameras
-	Microwaves
-	Small Freon appliances, dorm sized refrigerators, window ac units, dehumidifiers (Fee applies see website for current pricing)

HHM Residential Household Users Drop Off Hours:

Tuesday: 8:00 AM - 4:00 PM
Wednesday: 10:00 AM - 6:00 PM
Thursday: Noon - 4:00 PM
1st & 3rd Saturdays: 9:00 AM– Noon

*Residential household users with large loads of hazardous waste (greater than 250 lbs) or with large containers (more than 10 gal) need to schedule an appointment for materials drop off. Call 608-785-9999 for an appointment.

*Small business and Organization customers by appointment only. Call 608-785-9999 for appointment. Businesses and organizations will **NOT** be allowed to drop off waste without an appointment.

Proper Handling & Disposal

- Call 785-9999** for information on proper transportation and disposal of hazardous materials.
- When possible, deliver items in their original containers, or clearly mark contents on container.
- Inspect containers for damage or leaks; tighten all lids before transporting.
- Put leaking containers, separately, into a leak proof container.
- NEVER MIX CHEMICALS!**

The HHM facility is located at the La Crosse County Landfill Complex. Take State Highway 16 East toward West Salem. The Facility is approximately 1 mile East of Interstate 90; located on the south side of State Road 16. See red star. ★

Businesses and Non-Residents

Businesses or organizations, which qualify as Very Small Quantity Generators (VSQG), can utilize the program for a fee. VSQGs must pre-register and schedule an appointment before bringing materials to the collection facility. Call 785-9999 to receive a VSQG qualification packet.

Non-La Crosse County residents utilizing the program will be assessed a fee and should call for an appointment.




