

**NOTICE OF REFERENDUM  
TOWN OF BURNS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that at an election to be held in the Town of Burns, La Crosse County, Wisconsin on November 6, 2018, the following proposed Resolution of the Town Board will be submitted to a vote of the people:

**RESOLUTION No. 9-13-2018 #1  
RESOLUTION CLERK TREASURER APPOINTMENT**

**BE IT RESOLVED**, on July 10, 2018 the Town Board passed Clerk Treasurer Appointment Ordinance No. 7-10-2018 #1; That, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 60.30(1e)(a), the office of the town clerk or the town treasurer shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the town board. This ordinance is subject to approval by the town electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the Town Board to be on the November 6, 2018 ballot.

The question will appear on the ballot as follows:

"Shall the person holding the office of the town clerk or the town treasurer in the Town of Burns be appointed by the town board?"

**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT AND EFFECT OF VOTE**

The referendum election ballot will ask Town electors to vote "yes" or "no" on the referendum election question as set forth above.

A YES vote will result in the Town of Burns town board being authorized to appoint a resident or nonresident town clerk and a town treasurer. The town board will be responsible for managing the appointees in these offices.

A NO vote will result in the electors of the Town of Burns electing a candidate for the offices of town clerk and town treasurer. If there are no candidates running for either the town clerk and or town treasurer the town board will appoint a town resident to perform the duties of either of these offices.
